#### 2023-2024 MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

#### **COLLEGE CREDITS/GRADES**

- 1. <u>Provisional Membership</u> Requirements:
  - a. Completed at least one Early College course and passed with a B Grade.
  - b. Currently enrolled in at least one Early College course and maintain BOTH a High School and College GPA of 3.5.
- 2. <u>Inducted Membership</u> Requirements:
  - a. Earned a minimum of 12 College Credits and a cumulative COLLEGE GPA of 3.5 or higher.
  - b. Be invited and accept membership into Beta Chi Omega.
  - c. Maintain BOTH a High School and College cumulative GPA of 3.5.
- 3. A cumulative GPA of a minimum of 3.5 for both high school and college.
  - a. Any F's (High School and/or College) will result in an automatic dismissal from the club.
  - b. Quarterly report cards are to be shown to the Advisor within one week of distribution. r

- 4. A current GPA below 3.0 will result in academic probation (Not being prioritized for any PTK Activities).
  - a. If next quarter's current GPA is not 3.0 or higher, then it will result in an automatic dismissal out of the club.
  - b. Terms of Academic Probation:
    - i. Only 1 probationary period (1 quarter long) is granted per semester.
    - ii. Grade checks must be submitted by the end of each quarter for high school and each semester for college classes.
    - iii. Members on probation are to continue attending meetings and participating in activities.
    - iv. If, for any reason, academic probation consequences are not met then membership will be dismissed.

#### **MEETINGS AND ACTIVITIES**

- 1. ALL Meetings are MANDATORY ATTENDANCE (Bi-weekly)
  - a. 2 unexcused absences are allowed (per semester)
    - i. IF more than 2 unexcused absences occur, members will result in dismissal from the club.
  - b. Unexcused reasons will include: Finishing tests/classwork or projects, attending other club meetings, work, etc.
  - Absences due to illness should be cleared with an excuse note as soon as possible to an advisor or VP of Communications
- 2. \*IF a member volunteers for an activity and does not attend without 24 hour notice to an advisor or officer, he/she will receive 1 absence and be put on probation for one quarter.

#### 2023-2024 MEMBER REQUIREMENTS (45 Points)

SERVICE - (30 points):

- Required 15 points each semester, MINIMUM 10 pts with PTK.
- Each Services rated on a **10 Point scale**:

Point Scale	Type of Service
1-2	Donations/Drives (Lei, Can Food Drive, etc.) *Max 6 pts. per donation service (e.g., 5 leis = 2 points)*
3-4	1-2 hour service events (event set-up, clean-up, blood drive)
5-6	2-3 hour participation services (awareness walks, sign-waving, etc.)
7-8	3-4 hour service events NON-Laborious (PTK Induction, Waipahu's Got Talent)
9-10	3(+) hour events with Manual Labor (Beach/Park Clean-ups)

#### FELLOWSHIP - (2 Points)

- Must attend a minimum of 1 planned Fellowship per semester

#### LEADERSHIP - (10 Pts.)

- Required MINIMUM 5 Points per Semester
- Each Leadership event rated at a 2-point scale:

Point Scale	Type of Leadership Event	
2	CRASH, TAGNAWA Professional Development, College Presentations, Leadership Camps for Student Gov. or Council.	
*3	PTK Type Events (Regional Meetings, Attend Induction, Attend WGT, PTK Edge Courses, Etc.)	

#### SCHOLARSHIP - (3 Pts.)

- Must complete **3** Scholarship Categories at the end of the School Year 2023-2024

Point Scale	Type of Leadership Event
1	Academic Research: Research Papers, Subject Specific Research Studies Writing Newspaper Articles/Books Certifications: CPR Training, Google Certified, Serve Safe, Etc. WHS Honors: CTE, STEM, and/or ACADEMIC
2	College Honors: Completing an EC Honors Course and/or AP Course
3	Program Industry Certifications/Degree - Completing a Degree, CHW, Med Assist
