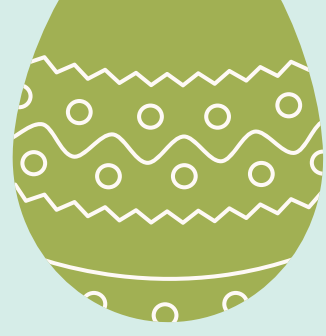
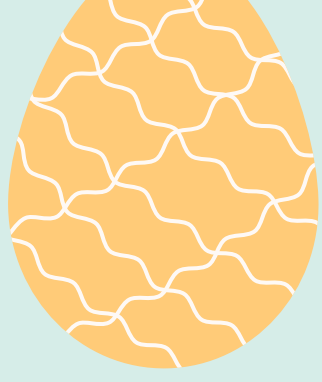
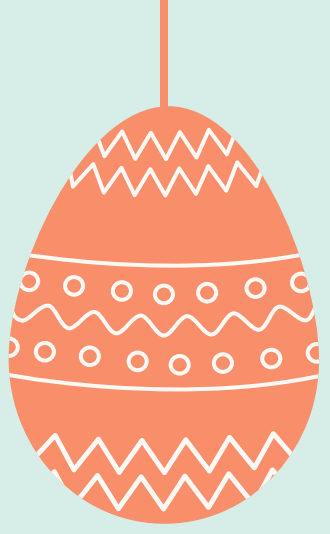
Good Friday is an observed state holiday. There are no Early College courses on Friday, April 3rd. The Early College Office will be closed.

A completed application includes the Summary Tag, signed Parent Consent Form, signed Dual Credit Application, and proof of completed UH online application. The minimum score for the English EdReady is 75, while the minimum score for Math Pathway II is 72. EdReady Assistance Sessions will be held in the V-Conference Room, 1st Floor of V-Building from 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.
